SAUVIGNON BLANC

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Often referred to as the “King of Red Wine Grapes”, Cabernet Sauvignon is originally from Bordeaux, but now has a strong foothold on the California wine scene. It has the honor of being the world’s most sought-after red wine. Cabernets range from medium to full-bodied and are noted for their high tannin content, which provides structure and interest while supporting the rich fruit characteristics. The flavor profile includes plum, cherry, blackberry, blueberry, warm spice, vanilla, tobacco and sometimes hints of leather.

ZINFANDEL

Originally thought to be a native Italian grape, Zinfandel has been a cornerstone of California wine-making since the mid-1800s. The wine is noted for its rich, dark color, medium to high tannins and relatively high alcohol content. On the palate, it has notes of raspberry, blackberry, cherry, plum, raisin, spice and black pepper, mixed with touches of oak.

PINOT NOIR

Adored by critics and cherished by collectors, Pinot Noir is a tantalizing yet temperamental varietal. For many wine enthusiasts, this is part of the Pinot's appeal – it does not reveal its charms easily. The Pinot Noir's virtue stems partially from the unique characteristics of the grape. The skins are delicate, which accounts for the lighter color and body of the finished wine. However, despite the delicacy, the best wines have excellent backbone and length, as this grape provides aromatic intensity unlike any other.

MERLOT

Merlot wine is characterized by red fruits, easy tannins and a soft finish. But there's more to Merlot than smoothness. This wine is actually a bit of a chameleon – its character changes depending on the conditions of the region where the vines are cultivated. When grown in cool climates, Merlots are more structured, with higher levels of tannins and earthy flavors like tobacco and tar. When produced in warm climates, the wine is more fruit-forward and the tannins are less pronounced.

SHIRAZ

Shiraz is known for its spicy notes of blackberry, plum and pepper, which are often combined with hints of licorice, bitter chocolate and mocha. It is a wine that is affected by growing temperature - warmer climates bring out the mellower flavors of plum, while cooler temperatures spice up the wine. Shiraz can be produced in a fruity style, which many "sweet" wine drinkers enjoy, but can also be made in a dry style.
